

Currently Working On:

- US Dept of Education, Perkins Innovation & Modernization Program; Up to \$7,375,000 over 5 years available (budget is being developed currently) to provide evidence-based and innovative strategies and activities to improve and modernize career and technical education (CTE) and ensure workforce skills taught in CTE programs align with labor market needs. Match of 50% required.
- United Way of Southern Kentucky; requesting funding for Jump Start Kindergarten, FRYSC support, and for high school college/career readiness. This will be for 2025.

Submitted Grants:

- US Dept. of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance STOP School Violence Program; \$1,000,000 over 3 years to prevent violence in the K-12 school setting by training school personnel and educating students on preventing school violence, including strategies to improve a school climate. No match required.
- United Way of Southern Kentucky; College and Career Readiness Grant, FRYSC Grant, Jump Start Kindergarten Grant requests.
- Laura Goad Turner Charitable Foundation; Requesting funds to assist in funding more students in our dual-credit course program in their junior and senior year of high school, and requesting funds for our FRYSC programs.

Recently Awarded Grants:

- American Rescue Plan Homeless Children & Youth Sub-grant Application for identification and professional development. Awarded \$35,000 for identification & implementation of services for homeless youth in the district and for attending the National Conference for the Education of Homeless Children and Youth (NAEHCY).
