

Grants working on/submitted needing approval:

- US Dept of Education, Perkins Innovation & Modernization Program; Up to \$7,375,000 over 5 years available (budget is being developed currently, we likely will not be requesting the full available amount) to provide evidence-based and innovative strategies and activities to improve and modernize career and technical education (CTE) and ensure workforce skills taught in CTE programs align with labor market needs. Match of 50% required.
- United Way of Southern Kentucky; currently working on Letters of Intent for Jump Start Kindergarten, FRYSC support, and high school college and career readiness support. This is the precursor for submitting a full application for each area in December/January. Funding would be for 2025.
