Social-Emotional and Behavior

September is focused on the Character Strong character trait **Respect**. Every classroom is using the Character Strong platform to help encourage engaging, meaningful discourse about Respect during their daily morning meeting. This time is devoted to building positive relationships and a positive respectful culture.

Behind the scenes, Ms. Craig is also working hard to utilize the resources provided by the Character Strong Tier 2 program. This program is helping us use data to identify what types of behavioral interventions might work best for individual students. It will also help us progress monitor and adjust the interventions as needed.

GES Student Recognition

- Student of the Month Every month, each grade level team will choose a student based on ACADEMIC themes. September theme is writing. Reward: These students will be recognized at the monthly board meeting and participate in our end of the month celebration. Families will be invited to the BISD Board meeting.
- <u>Character Strong Tiger Traits</u> Classroom teachers will recognize a student following the Character Strong traits. Reward: We will call them down to the office for a photo. Allison will display the certificate and photo outside her room. These students will participate in our end of the month celebration.
- <u>Positive Office Referral</u> Any staff member can recognize a student for following the Character Strong traits and fill out a form. Reward: Name announced, message sent home by teacher, student picks from treasure chest in office.
- <u>100 Compliments Chart</u> When classrooms receive a compliment in the GES common areas (hallway, specials, lunchroom, playground, etc.) they get a star on their hundred's chart. Reward: After each 25 compliments, the classroom chooses from a menu of rewards (PJ day, popcorn party, etc.).

Preschool

• We invited all Preschool students in for preschool transition days and students were able practice before the first day of preschool. They enjoyed their classroom, met their teachers, and began learning daily routines and procedures.

MTSS

The Initial round of MTSS meetings K-5 were a huge success!

- All students K-5 have been assessed using NSGRA to determine their instructional reading level.
- Kindergarten teachers are working to complete Brigance
- Kinder-5th teachers are working to complete Easy CBM to help drive math instruction.
- Students needing Tier 2 and 3 support have been identified in reading and math.
- Students have been identified for reading intervention. Ms. Welscher will utilize University of Florida Literacy Institute (UFLI) and Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) during Tier 2 and 3 intervention.
- Students needing Tier 2 and 3 math support will be administered individual math interviews to determine skill deficits for Tier 1 differentiation in the classroom.
- Data collected is also being used to drive instruction in after school program.

- PLC teams are utilizing NWEA's Student Level Analysis Protocol to help analyze student MAP data.
