We've received our first KETS Offer for FY24. The first offer is confirmed to be at \$12 per student with a total of \$21 by the time the third offer comes through. The total amount received will be approximately \$250,000. I ask that we preemptively approve all three offers now which will eliminate the need for further approval of the remaining offers thus reducing the time to get them back.

Our department will continue to use these funds to provide student and teacher devices, data center hardware, networking hardware, and other instructional-related technologies.


