# Collaboration



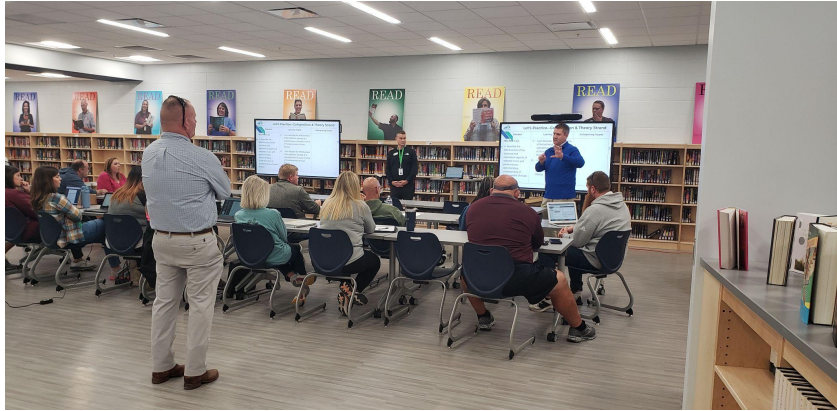
Marion County Middle School students in Mr. Hardin's STEM class discussed their 3-D printing projects with Calvary Elementary 5th graders

The groups met via video chat using the panel and camera systems MCPS purchased through the RUS grant.



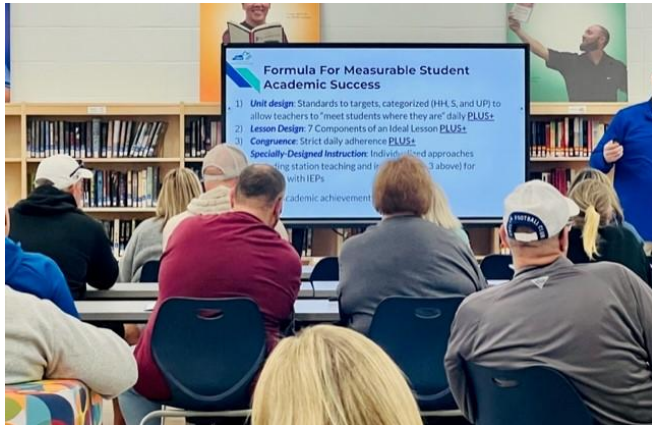


# Staff Development Day
