4.) Next, Betsy Layne High School, Jody Roberts, Anna Shepherd, and Board Members. 30 minutes

We shared our concerns about the sophomore scores from last year. Sophomores scored low in both reading and math. These students are now juniors, and we are concerned about junior scores for this year. We have incorporated strategies that we think may help the students score higher this year.

We identified students who scored novice/apprentice on last year's MAP test, ACT test, and KSA tests. Those students were divided amongst content teachers to provide extra support in the areas they were weak in. These students will meet 3 days a week for 30 minutes with their assigned teacher.

We identified students who had not had biology and/or US History, but are scheduled to take the tests this year. Those students were given 3 days a week for 30 minutes to work on those subjects with a content teacher.

We talked about the need of an Intercom system at the front office. This is a safety concern, and we were assured this would be taken care of.

We let them know that the girl's bathroom has reoccurring issues regarding leaks.

We told them that we need more cameras in the parking lot, baseball field, and football field.

Our alarm system does not work, and has not worked since the new addition was added.

We discussed with the board members the need for less in person meetings at the board. Meetings should be rotated from school to school for in person meetings, virtual meetings should be utilized when possible.

For future reference, the special called meeting with site based councils should be scheduled. Several schools waited over an hour before they were able to talk to anyone.
