The goals were State Assessment Results in Reading and Math; State Assessment Results in Science, Social Studies, and Combined Writing; Achievement Gap, English Learner Progress; Quality of School Climate and Survey; Post-secondary Readiness; and Graduation Rate. Objectives over the next three years were developed along with

four focus areas; Professional Learning Communities (PLCs), Assessment, Accelerated Learning, and Climate & Culture. These focus areas contain strategic activities, measures of success, and funding.
