 include teaching artists' visits, arts assemblies, and arts field trips supporting instruction in the
 visual and performing arts (art, dance, music, and theatre). Funds may be used to pay teaching
 artists or organizations, admission for students and relevant adults, transportation, and other
 allowable costs directly related to each arts experience.
- Provide receipts or other documentation of allowable expenses.
