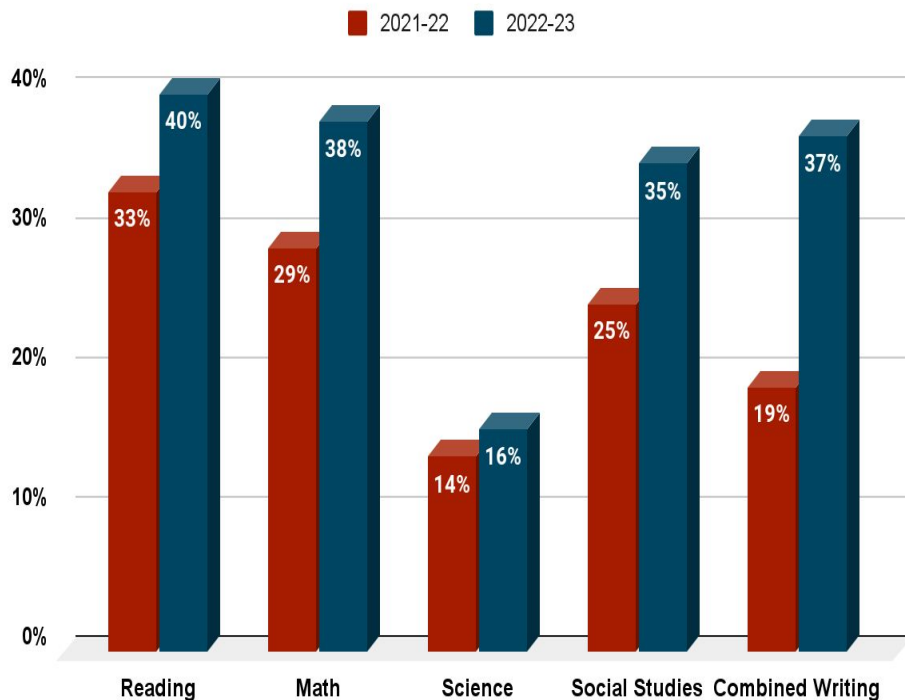
# Overall Designations

- The ratings will be reported using a color rating system to communicate performance of schools, with Red being the lowest rating and Blue being the highest rating.



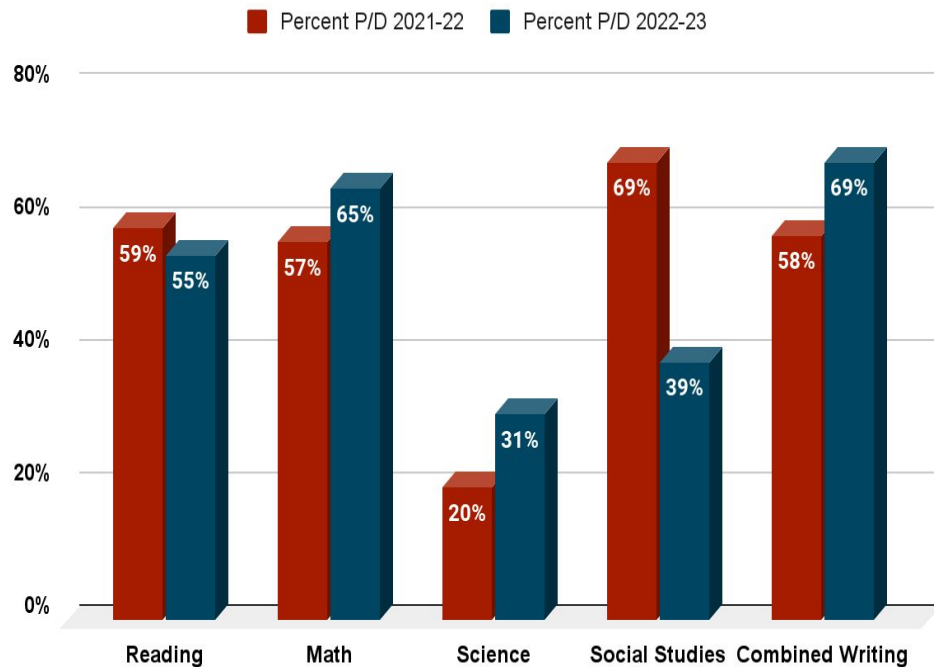

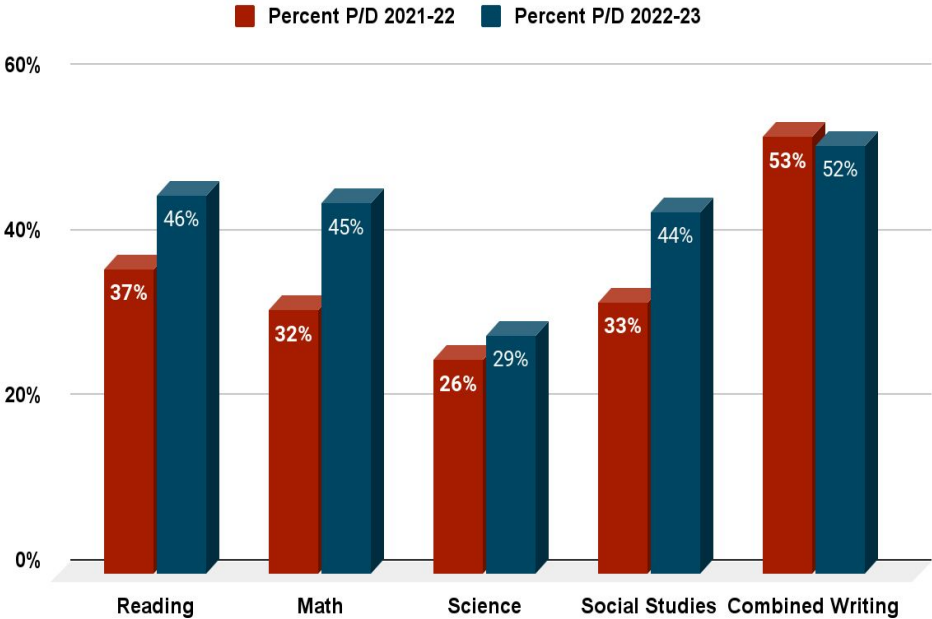

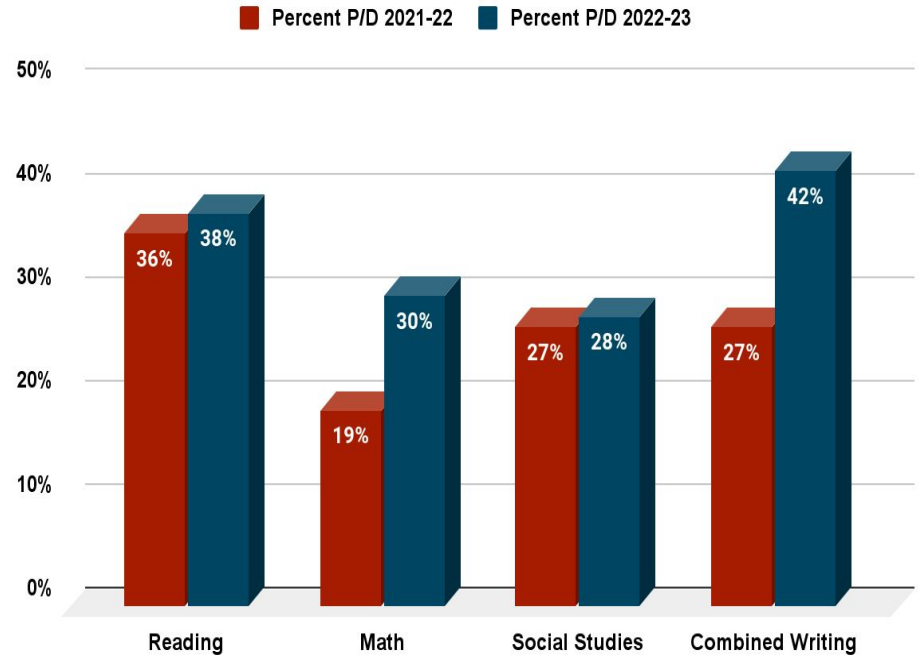

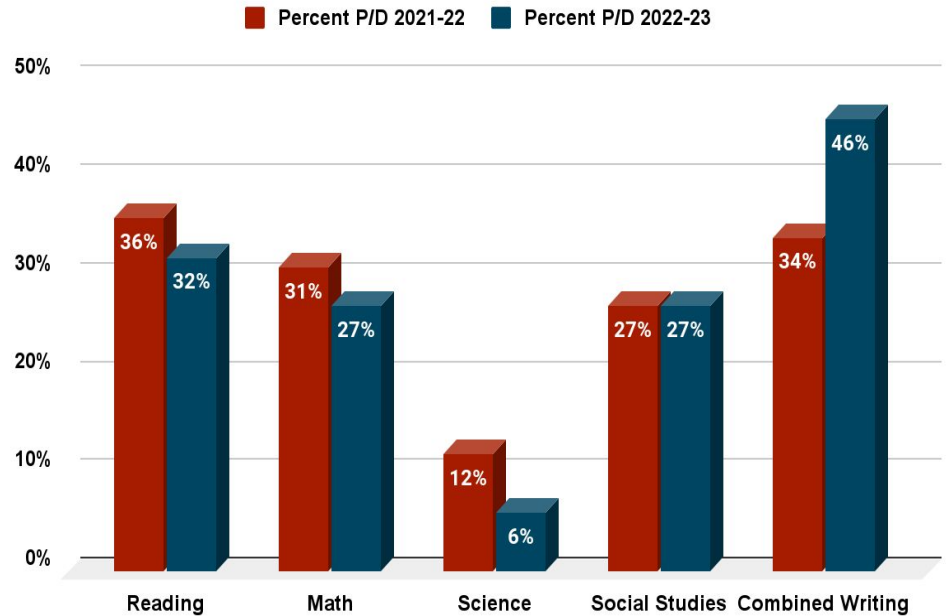
