

## Attendance

Attendance month 3 ended on November 13, 2023. After each school balances month 3, the month will be locked and reporting will occur at the next regular board meeting.

## Title I, Part A

The Consolidated Application within the Grant Management System has been approved by the Title I Consultant at KDE in October. We are awaiting KDE finance to review prior to requesting funds. Each school Principal has received their budget and narrative for expenditures. Schools are currently holding parent teacher conferences as part of their Title I plan.

## Newport Independent Schools Pupil Personnel, Student Services, & Federal Programs

We have the addition of one private school participating in Title I through Equitable Service Provisions. Newport Independent and Saint Therese have completed the Equitable Service Agreement and have already begun implementation.

## Title I, Part D

Title I, Part D has been reviewed and approved by the Kentucky Department of Education. Title I, Part D funds in the amount of \$72,093.00 have been allocated toward one full time transition coordinator already on staff. District set aside funds have been utilized to provide online instructional programming for students.

We serve delinquent students at Newport Regional School, an A6 alternative school. Prior notice was received that we would be switching to an all male facility. As of November 13, 2023, 3 female students remain and we have not received a date to receive male students.

Superintendent Watts and Principal Anthony Piccirrillo are currently working with the Department of Juvenile Justice for a Memorandum of Agreement for educational services provided to the Campbell County Regional Juvenile Detention Center. Newport Regional School continues to have adequate staff and are prepared to continue providing students with access to their education. Should we have a time where there are no students at NRS, staff will report to other schools within the district at the direction of the Superintendent.
