

One week later. There has consistently been an issue with the district tournament for high school soccer having to take place during fall break.

Follow Logan Co School District schedule

A two week fall break scheduled at the same time as Logan County High School is needed to align with the CTC and JROTC programs for our students, as well as, for those faculty and staff who have spouses, children, or other family members at the county school. Not aligning our schedule more closely to fit the county school is a disservice to our students and those teachers whose classes are continuously interrupted with our students arriving early or late to class.

If only one week, then either would work. "

2 weeks for fall break would be great!

The first week works well.

A later break doesn't matter to me - I like it better when the breaks line up with the 9 week cut offs.

2 days for fall break and a week for Thanksgiving

If it has "always" been the first week of October why would it be moved?

Fall Break should probably fall at the end of the first quarter. This provides a hard break that is beneficial to planning and students knowing where they stand in a class.

if it provides a better "breaking point" the 7th to 11th is fine

This week has shown that at the high school, the students that go to CTC are not getting additional instruction since both Logan and Todd county are still out and ROTC students are not even able to go to their classes this week at all, so we have to have a place for them to be supervised here. So, based on that alone, I feel that we should be thinking about being on a schedule closer to LCS just for high school CTC students to benefit.

That date would be fine.

I think we should schedule to have two full weeks of fall break instead of only one.

Stay with traditional first full week

Timing Fall Break to be the end of the Q1 grading period is more significant to me than a traditional week.

Students would benefit from a 2wk break by increasing their productivity in terms of processing and reflecting previous learning.

I think that keeping this schedule is beneficial to both. Taking a break to soon after the start of the school year doesn't give the students time to retain the information they have been learning.

I would like it to be Oct. 7-11...that way we would be on the same schedule with other schools around us

This plan usually works well and goes with the Tobacco Festival week. This year it was a little off which made fall break seem a little off. Sometimes I think it would be nice to get the first quarter in (more natural break) before fall break.

I would vote for 2 weeks of fall break.

With Easter being so late this year, I think the main consideration should be to time as close to the end of the Q3 grading period as possible.

Students would benefit from two weeks of break in the spring by reducing their stress levels as we approach testing and end of the year assessments.

Having a later spring break gives the students a "countdown to summer" mentality. On the other hand, as a parent, I have always felt an earlier break would be better for learning and prepping for the end of the year.

Logan Co District calendar

Following the two week break in the fall and spring would be beneficial for students who go to CTC. Based on the various calendars between us, Todd, and Logan, these students do not get as much instruction time.

For multiple reasons, i feel like it would be beneficial to follow the same schedule as Logan County. The CTC is affected, families have students in both districts, and I feel like our students' performance is lower the week we are in school but Logan isn't when they see friends are off and they aren't.

Possibility of 2 weeks for both spring and fall break

Please don't shorten teachers Winter Break. We deserve 2 full weeks.

Two week breaks

Two weeks of spring break like Logan County

I was in a district that did two days for fall break and then a week for thanksgiving. I really liked that schedule as it didn't break routines during the fall semester and having a week at Thanksgiving was better than having a week earlier in the year."

The students having the Monday off after fall break doesn't make much sense to me. Could that curriculum day not be moved to another Monday or Friday later in October.

I do not know if it is effective but LC has two weeks at each break. Instead of Mondays off, use Fridays instead or include Fridays, especially weekends that are around holidays.

2 week fall break/spring break

Early Release Friday every week

PD/Curriculum days first day back from fall, holiday, and spring breaks

Reduce to 171 instructional days so there are two additional curriculum/PD days for teachers to either prepare before the school year starts or have strategic days placed within the year when planning, grades, etc., are at the heaviest demand.

Our neighboring district provides students and families 2 weeks for fall break, spring break, winter break.

Our students travel to CTC and our schedule enables our students to be the only students back upon the return from breaks for that first week.

If we have breaks the same time as surrounding schools everything will be fine


Soccer district tournament is always the first full week of October. Region is the following week.

Marching Band for fall


## **Staff Rank In Order**

#### Would be great to be on the same schedule as Logan Co District

I think having a full 2 weeks for fall and one for spring would be nice. Or even a week and half for each. If they were able to do a week and a half teachers could use the remainder of the week we returned to reestablish procedures.

I would like 2 weeks of fall break and 1 of spring, and 2 full weeks winter break. Starting school August 7 would be fine if the above is meet.

I would love to be semi the same with logan county school schedules.

Having 2 weeks for Spring Break and 2 weeks for Fall Break has been discussed for YEARS at RISD. It's time to make it happen! Change is good.

I'm not opposed to adding more time to fall or spring break as long as we don't start school any earlier or end school any later.

Again, just trying to align our calendars with the other two CTC schools for our high school students that choose a career pathway there. I do go to the CTC quite often and can see both RHS and CTC side of things as a big picture in the need for more alignment.

#### Being able to end school at 2:50

The 4-day week school calendar has been effective in recruiting teachers to rural areas where compensation is not the highest in the region. There is also no statistically significant difference in student achievement for students in a 4-day or traditional 5-day a week school calendar since the total yearly instructional hours are virtually the same. Since most holidays fall on Monday or can be designated to a Monday, many of these schools either go Tuesday - Friday and totally close on Mondays or have only teachers attend on various Mondays throughout the year for collaborative planning, PD, etc. This quality-of-life benefit to employees would be worth a consideration in future years if recruitment continues to be a struggle. It does require strong collaboration with community partners to provide activities, supervision, and support for students on the one day a week when school is not in session. However, if the day off is consistent (always Monday, always Friday, etc.), most communities find solutions that benefit everyone.

#### Any additional considerations for the calendar committee?

I rated 1 being the most important, then so on. I would prefer 2 weeks off at spring break instead of at fall break...I would prefer to start school at the beginning of August and get out in the middle of May. It would be nice for Russellville, Todd, and Logan to be on the same calendar. I was in a school where we had Good Friday off and Monday after Easter (This could have been used as a snow make up if needed) Elementary school schedule Grandparents Day luncheon the week before the holiday.

I'm used to getting out for Christmas break on a Friday. It's unusual that we're going to school on the Monday & Tuesday before Christmas.

Monday off before election day in fall due to disconnect of instructional standards.

We should match Logan calendar they start same day and still get 2 weeks fall and spring break and only get out 4 days after us

You will never make everyone happy:) Need to consider the fact that parents might have a hard time getting a sitter for 2 weeks vs. one if you went to

2 weeks Fall Break or Spring Break. Unless the parent works in the school system they probably don't have that kind of time to be taking off.

I would love to see Russellville go to 2 week breaks! I feel that if we do that we may need to consider food service options for our students.

It would be nice to be on the same schedule as Logan County since we have many students who attend LCCTC.

Students focus decreases greatly after testing at the end of the year. Potentially develop a calendar that would keep instruction from going too far past that day. At the same time I have noticed some people like to go to school later when the weather is still hot and get out of school later when it is not as cold outside. Both of these things be something to take into consideration.

#### Any additional considerations for the calendar committee?

With the idea of a 2 week Fall and Spring break calendar I think it could be beneficial that with the second week letting the students who are behind in a class and want to get caught up in that class the option of coming in and working with a teacher to do such. it would be nice to get out at 1 on the last day of school.

Use the day before Election Day as a PD so students aren't going Monday then off Tuesday and back for the rest of the week!!

I think we should do breaks the same time as the schools around us

I believe that allowing an additional week of fall break will better allow both students and parents a chance for decompression before entering into the next 9 weeks and the busiest season of the year.

Adjusting our time table for days of instruction could help balance the stress load by allowing more time for a mental health reset in-between grading periods.

The reason I believe this is because removing the mental work load of school can allow for more time can be spent catching up and getting ahead while also being able to slow down a beat and reset for both students and parents. "
