## **GUIDANCE COUNSELOR'S REPORT - H. McDougall**

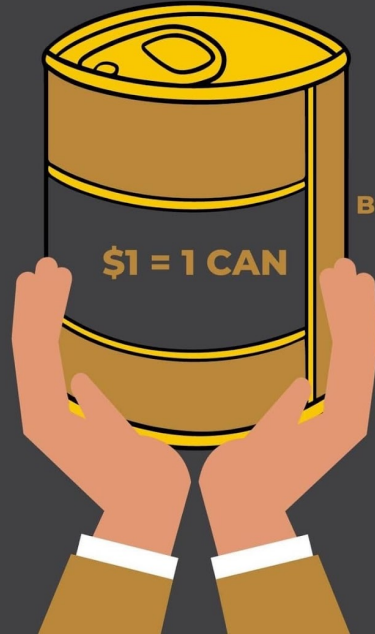
- I attended the Defiant Student Training with Ms. Young and Ms. McDougall. It was a two day training on Larry Thompson's Responsibility Centered Discipline model.
