September 25, 2023

Board approved Bid documents and to advertise for bids (Order# 20390).

Bids were accepted by RossTarrant and opened at 2:00 pm with one (1) bid being received by Spray Foam Technologies of KY in the amount of \$3,120,000.00. The bid was over budget and after discussion with the Superintendent the decision was made to rebid the project and do the exterior only.

November 21, 2023

Bids were accepted by RossTarrant and opened at 2:00 pm with two (2) bids being received by Dixie Roofing, Inc (\$2,235,100.00) and Kalkrenth Roofing & Sheet Metal (\$2,364,906.00).

Recommended Action: To reject the bid from Spray Foam Technologies of KY in its entirety. Accept the bid from Dixie Roofing, Inc and award a contract for Bid Package #2 Dome roof and Revised BG-1 as presented, pending KDE approval.
