November 16th, 2023

Meeting was called to order at 3:31.

Council reviewed the current agenda. Karen Henson made a motion to approve the agenda; motion was seconded by Michael Betts. All were in consensus.

Council reviewed the October meeting minutes. Kayla Hindle made a motion to approve the minutes; motion was seconded by Mika Tyler. All were in consensus.

Heather Goodman shared the Principal's report with council members including the following information:

- Enrollment- The school currently has 453 students.
- Updates:

 - Merry Morningside is on December 5th from 5:30-7:00.
 - Club day is scheduled for December 8th.
 - We will have a school wide field trip to the State Theatre in December.
 - PTO will provide lunch for the staff on December 14th.

Council reviewed the Budget Reports for Section 6 and Activity Accounts. There were no questions about the budget reports.

Council reviewed the KSA 2023 Analysis. Heather Goodman shared that MES scores improved from the previous year. We went from an overall score in the yellow in 2021-22 to an overall green score in 2022-23. The council looked at specific subject scores, as well as grade level scores. There were no questions about the KSA 2023 Analysis.

Council reviewed the CSIP- Phase Two- Needs Assessment for Schools. Michael Betts made a motion to approve this phase; Karen Henson seconded. All were in consensus.

Heather Goodman presented Council with the second reading of Policy 25.01, School-wide Writing Program. Council reviewed the document and determined that there were not any changes that needed to be made. Kayla Hindle motioned to approve the policy; Michael Betts seconded. All were in consensus.
