Academics

Student of the Month academic theme this month is Science.

Math and Reading Intervention

2nd round of MTSS meetings K-5

Students needing Tier 2 and 3 support have been discussed & decisions were made about interventions moving forward in reading and math.

Ms. Welscher will continue to utilize University of Florida Literacy Institute (UFLI) and Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) during Tier 2 and 3 intervention for reading.

Students needing Tier 2 and 3 math support have taken the iReady assessment to determine skill deficits for intervention in the classroom and during the after-school program.

KSA Scores

2022-2023 scores have been shared with students 3rd-5th during one-on-one discussions with admin team.

KMIT Evaluation

As a requirement of our MAF grant, Kelly DeLong will be coming back to Grandview the week of 12/4 to collect data for the second time this year on questioning and discourse in our mathematics classrooms.

MAP

All students K-5 are completing the second round of MAP assessments in reading and math during the week of 12/4. Every student has set a growth goal for the upcoming assessment.

- How will we know if they learned it?
