

Special Education & Preschool Board Report

December 2023

- 1. The December 1 Count has been completed and submitted. We currently have 39 students receiving Special Education, with several more in the evaluation process.
 - a. The December 1 count is the official count for students being served under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA)
 - b. The count includes all students 3-21 who have active IEPs on December 1 each school year.
 - c. The count is used for calculation of Exceptional Child Add-On to SEEK Funding for the following school year.
- 2. Mrs. Buse has been working on administering the Fall Alternate Assessment testing to our 4 students who are currently on alternate assessment. The Fall testing window ends on December 15, 2023, and all testing will be completed by then. There is also a Spring testing window that Mrs. Buse will administer the testing for.
- 3. Happy to announce that Mr. Collett, one of the MSD Instructional Assistants we hired this year, has found his passion here at Southgate and has been accepted into the Option 6 program for Special Education at the University of the Cumberlands beginning in January.
