### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

The Division of School and Community Nutrition (SCN), KDE, and USDA mistakenly awarded grants for free fresh fruits and vegetables to children during the school day for multiple schools: RR, BG, WT, CY, TM, and FW, which were all previously approved by the Board. The Student Nutrition Director applied for a grant for BG only. Once SCN, KDE, and USDA realized their error, they withdrew grants for all schools except BG. The signature page also needs to be updated since the Director of Student Nutrition has changed since the FFVP grant was awarded.
