**Background/Rationale:** The KY School-Safety & Resiliency Act established that each board of education shall develop a plan for implementing a trauma -informed approach in its schools. Since 2016, Fayette County Public Schools has focused on building capacity among staff, students and families as a trauma-informed school community. Activities have included partnering with our university partner, UKY Center for Trauma & Children, to develop training modules, increasing training of specialists in trauma-informed interventions, promoting staff wellness and awareness of secondary traumatic stress, establishing on-boarding of new hires and district wide outreach to the community. The Department of Student Support Services will provide an annual update to the Board of Education.
