1. State Assessment Results in Reading and Math Goals

- Goal: By 2027, the percentage of students proficient in reading will increase from 40% to at least 60% at Marion County Middle School.
 - Objective: By May 2024, student proficiency rate for reading will be at least 50%.
- Goal: By 2027, the percentage of students proficient in math will increase from 34% to at least 60% at Marion County Middle School.
 - Objective: By May 2024, student proficiency rate for math will be at least 50%.

 - Objective: By May 2024, at least 75% of English Learner students at Marion County Middle School will score at the Expanding Classification (3.0 or higher) on the ACCESS test.

- Goal: By 2027, the indicator score for the Quality of School Climate and Safety will be at least 80 at Marion County Middle School.
 - Objective: By May 2024, the indicator score for Quality of School Climate and Safety will have an index of at least 71.
