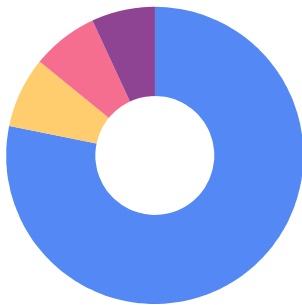

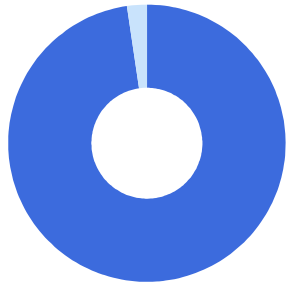

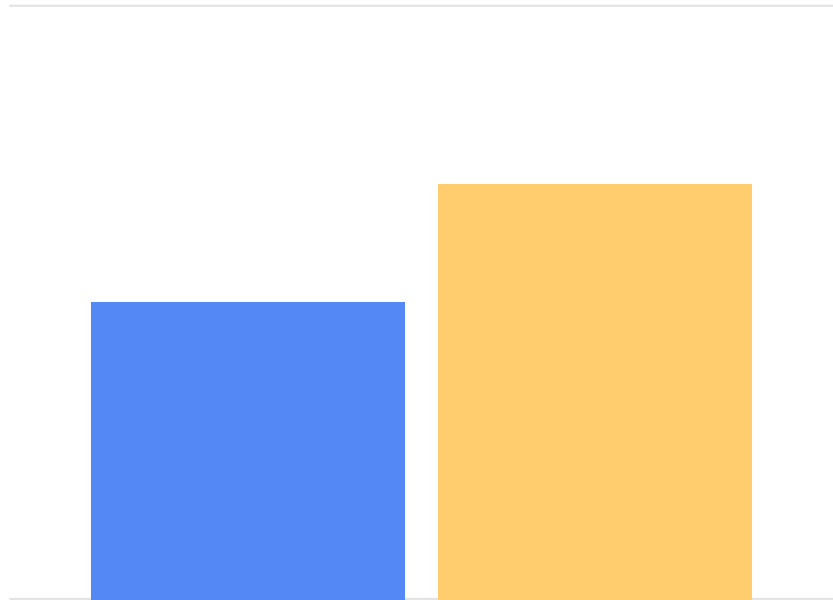
How are students performing academically?

Students are assessed in grades 3-8, 10 and 11 in a variety of subjects on tests that were developed by Kentucky teachers. Students in grade 11 also take a college admissions exam. For each subject assessment, students are ranked as either Distinguished, Proficient, Apprentice or Novice. Comparisons may be made between school and district performances based on these performance scores.

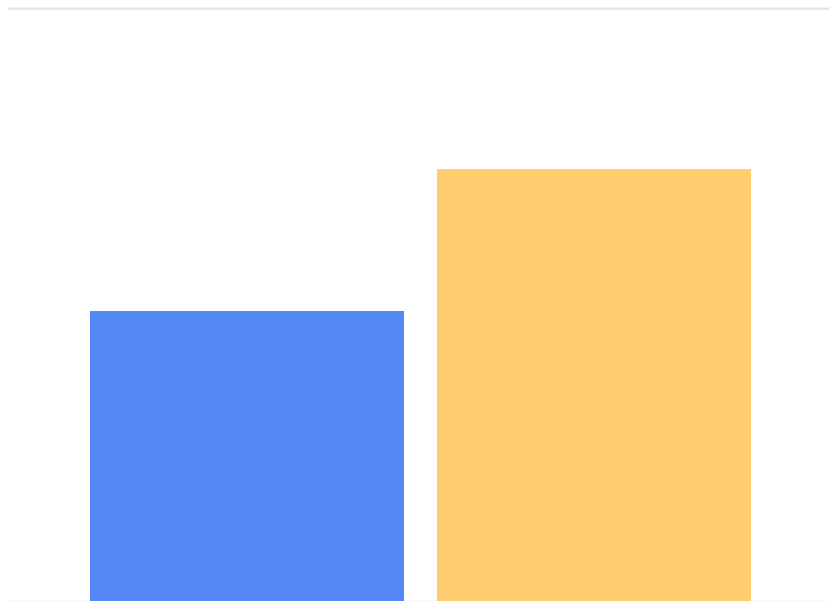

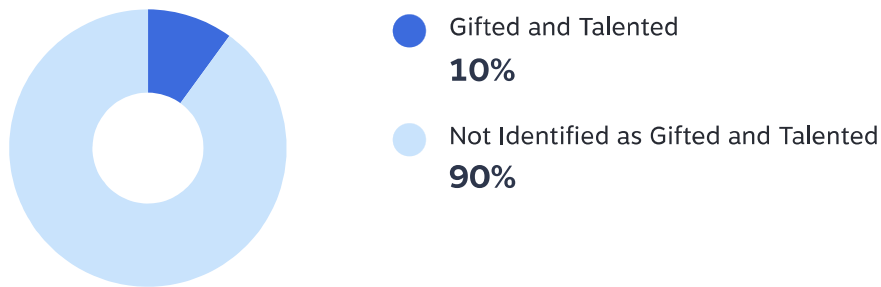

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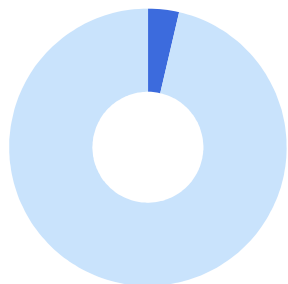

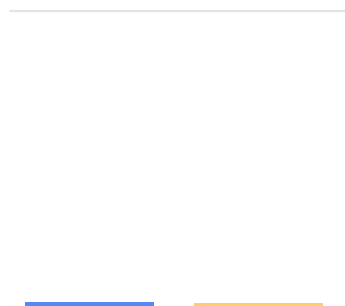
