This is a free, kindergarten-readiness program for parents with children who are five years old or younger.



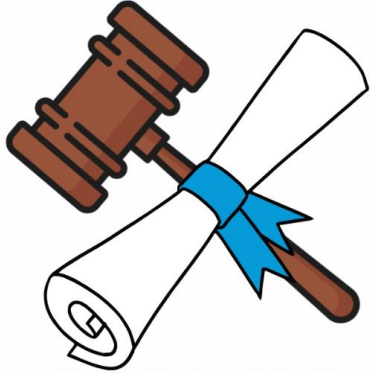
