By 2026 Stanton Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in:

- Reading from 37% (2023) to 47%.
- Math from 35% (2023) to 45%
- Science from 30% (2023) to 40%
- Social Studies for Elementary from 35% (2023) to 45%, Combined Writing/Editing and Mechanics for Elementary from 37% (2023) to 47%

By 2026 Stanton Elementary will increase:

- Climate index from 78.4 to 81.4
- Safety index from 71.1 to 74.1

KCWP 2: Design and Deliver Instruction

- Principal and teachers will meet weekly in PLC meetings to analyze student work, progress, MTSS implementation. Teachers will continue to plan implementing our new reading and math series.
