

By 2026 Powell County High School will increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in:

- By 2026 PCHS will increase the percentage of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished in Reading from 23% (2023) to 33%.
- By 2026 PCHS will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in Math from 13% (2023) to 23%..
- By 2026, PCHS will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in Science by 30% overall.
- By 2026, PCHS will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in Social Studies from 15% (2023) to 25%.
- By 2026, PCHS will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in Combined Writing/Editing and Mechanics from 13% (2023) to 23%

By 2026 Powell County High School will increase:

- Postsecondary readiness rate from 78.1 to 85.1
- Climate index for High School from 60.1 to 80
- Safety index for High School from 54.4 to 75
- Graduation rate from 90.3 to 93
 - Implementation of new ELA and Math curricula
 - Purchased and began use of Mastery Connect for standards based formative assessments.
 - Continue use of ESS daytime waiver.
 - In the Spring use Mastery Connect as a predictive tool for the state assessment.
 - SS teachers are viewing sample curricula.
 - ELA department delivered writing PD for all staff and writing is being taught similarly in all content areas.
 - Crew time used to implement tiers of support or enrichment for all students.
 - Continue to work with multiple mental health agencies available to students.
