We would like to recognize our high school student musicians that have been selected for the All-State Band and Choir Ensembles. These students will come together with students from across the state at the Kentucky Music Educators Conference to make music together. The groups will perform during the first week of February at the Kentucky Performing Arts Center in Louisville.

First, we'll recognize our choir students. There were over 1,000 students from across the state that participated in the all-state choir auditions, and BCPS had 6 students selected to join the state-level choir based on their musical skills and performance.

Band students also had the opportunity to audition to join the All-State Instrumental Ensembles. These students participated in a two-round audition process with over 1,000 students competing for placement in the All-State Bands and Orchestra.
