

BGISD/KHSAA Agreed Order Update Report January 17, 2024

Listed below is a summary of the steps taken to implement the BGISD/KHSAA agreed order since the November 15, 2023 Board of Control Meeting.

- The residency requirements training for winter sports coaches occurred on November 14, 2023.
- Emergency Action Plans (EAP's) have been drilled for all of the following sports:
 - Boys Basketball
 - Girls Basketball
 - Bowling
 - Swim
 - Archery
 - Cheerleading
- All coaches have acknowledged they have reviewed the Coaches Handbook via Google Form.
- The Google Document that provides the names of middle school students that are on the varsity rosters was updated to include winter sports athletes. This was shared with Joe Angolia on November 3, 2023.
- All Fall and Winter sports coaches are NFHS Level 1 Certified and we are reviewing the status of spring sports coaches with respect to NFHS Level 1 Certification.
- Residency requirements training for spring sports coaches will be scheduled in the near future.
- Emergency Action Plan (EAP) drills as outlined in the Coaches Handbook will also be scheduled for spring sports in the near future.
- Once spring sports rosters are finalized the Google Document that provides names of middle school students that are on varsity rosters will be updated to reflect the participating athletes.
