These groups are created to meet students' academic needs. Each grade level's 7-10 WIN groups consist of groups for Gifted and Talented, on grade level and also intervention.

**School Play** – Auditions have been held for our spring production of **The Wizard of Oz** and practice has begun. The play will be held the weekend of April 18<sup>th</sup> – April 20<sup>th</sup>. We are so excited for this opportunity for our students! Our new stage curtains have been installed and look absolutely beautiful. The old stage curtains were 35 years old and non-functional. Also, the students of this cast will get to see a special 85<sup>th</sup> Anniversary showing of The Wizard of Oz movie on Sunday, January 28<sup>th</sup> at the AMC Theatre in Newport.
