Family Engagement Day #3 - Lincoln teachers and staff invited our Lincoln families in for our third Family Engagement Conference on Tuesday, January 16th. We are working at reaching 100% of our families by the end of next week. We focused the day's family discussions in these areas:

Benchmark Assessments – Our students completed their AIMSweb and STAR assessments in December before their winter break. We are pleased with the students' growth progress and have used this important winter data to create our new WIN ("What I Need") groups that have begun. These groups are created to meet students' academic needs. Each grade level's 7-10 WIN groups consist of groups for Gifted and Talented, on grade level and also intervention.

School Play – Auditions have been held for our spring production of *The Wizard of Oz* and practice has begun. The play will be held the weekend of April 18th – April 20th. We are so excited for this opportunity for our students! Our new stage curtains have been installed and look absolutely beautiful. The old stage curtains were 35 years old and non-functional. Also, the students of this cast will get to see a special 85th Anniversary showing of *The Wizard of Oz* movie on Sunday, January 28th at the AMC Theatre in Newport. This is made possible from Rosann Sharon's funds.
