

School Risk Assessment

- Required by law
- Conducted annually by the Office of State School Security Marshal
- Assessments can also be conducted randomly or after receiving a complaint
- All schools in the district must be compliant or the district fails as a whole
- Assessment is pass/fail
- Assessment covers approximately 100 items

Consequences for failure

- Danger to students, staff, visitors
- Criminal & Civil liability
- Withholding of state funds to the district

Sample Assessment Questions

- ID required to enter
- Electronically controlled front entrance
- Classroom doors shut & locked during instruction time
- Threat Assessment teams at each school
- SRO @ each school
- SRO's armed
- 1 Mental health worker per 250 students
- All hazards approach Emergency Operations Plan

WCPS Exceeds Expectations

- Armed SRO in each school
- Dual front entry electronically controlled front entry
- Ballistic upgrades
- 1 Mental health worker per 187 students

2023-2024 Assessment
