**Recommendation/Motion:** Approve a Resolution authorizing the sale, refunding of General Fund for applicable expenditures and issuance of School Building Revenue Bonds, in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$245,000,000.00 for the purposes of paying the costs (not otherwise paid) of the construction and equipping of a Girls' STEM School and Elementary School on Greendale Road and renovation/reconstruction of Henry Clay High School (the "Projects") for the Board of Education. Per the attached resolution of the official intent.

**Background/Rationale:** The Board desires and intends to finance up to \$245,000,000.00 of the costs of the construction and equipping of a Girls' STEM School, an Elementary School on Greendale Road and renovation/reconstruction of Henry Clay High School through Revenue Bonds by the Board's corporate agency and instrumentality, the Fayette County School District Finance Corporation, the interest on which bonds may qualify for exclusion from gross income for federal and Kentucky income tax purposes.
