Charge to the Screening Committee

Screening Committee shall:

- List the recommended applicants in alphabetical order and not ranked.
- Meet with the Board for the purpose of formally recommending and discussing candidates.

- Be student centered and have the desire to connect with our students.
- Have a record of improving student achievement and academic rigor.
- Exhibit excellent people skills.

- Possess a working knowledge of current Kentucky Educational trends.

- Be actively involved in the community and be willing to work collaboratively with the City of Dayton leadership.
- Represent and promote the district and its students at the local, state and national levels and collaborate to provide the best services available for all students.
