DISTRICT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT
AMENDMENT NO. 2 for DFP dated August 2021

A public hearing was held at **128 Walton Ave, Lexington, KY** on **December 20, 2023**, at **5:30 p.m.** (local time). The purpose of the public hearing was to propose an amended District Facility Plan developed by the **Fayette County** Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted **15-0** in favor of the proposed amended plan and the Board voted **4-0** to approve the amendment.

There were **(1) persons exclusive of the hearing officer** in attendance. **Melinda Joseph-Dezarn** served as the locally-appointed hearing officer. **Please see attached sign in sheet for those present.**

COMMENTS

The hearing officer called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. It was explained that those persons wishing to speak would be given the opportunity and that written statements would be accepted. All considerations will be made available to the Kentucky Board of Education via the hearing officer's report. The hearing officer read the proposed amendment to the District Facility Plan which included; **(1) constructing a new Henry Clay High School in lieu of a renovation and (2) adding Lansdowne Elementary School to the DFP. The new build of Henry Clay High will have the capacity of 2,300 students.**

The floor was opened to those who wished to make a statement, but no one was in attendance.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Amended District Facility Plan developed by the **Fayette County** Local Planning Committee and adopted by the **Fayette County** Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the **Fayette County** School District. A copy of the amended plan is attached.
