<p>Out of 454 students in Todd County schools, 32.6% of 12th, 24.8% of 10th, 16.7% of 8th and 1.8% of 6th reported that they have used vapes in the past 30 days. (KIP Survey 2021). 40.4% of 12th, 28% of 10th, 34.7% of 8th and 11/1% of 6th reported that they think dealing drugs in school is a problem.</p> <p>3. YSC will work with administration to target those caught with vapes (either nicotine or THC) to educate them more on addiction as well as provide them with how to quit if they are interested. 100% of those caught will be offered information.
