Dear Mr. Brock and Estill County School Board,

Subject: Proposal for use of school buses as a shuttle during the Mountain Mushroom Festival, April 27 and 28

The City of Irvine mayor James Gross, City of Irvine police chief John Sturniolo, and Mountain Mushroom Festival committee are planning for the 32nd annual festival. The bus shuttle service was so successful the last two years we would like to ask to provide the service again this year. We are striving to make the traffic flow as efficiently and quickly as possible. Following is our proposal.

- Use two Estill County School school buses as shuttles on Saturday, April 27, 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. and Sunday, April 28, 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Route #1 will be: pick-up point at the Estill County High School. Travel to the drop-off at the Central Office. Proceed to Park Avenue, Carhartt Avenue, and turn left at Main Street/Carhartt Avenue. Return to ECHS with continuous shuttles every 30 minutes.
- Route #2 will be: pick-up point at West Irvine Elementary School. Travel to the drop-off at the Central Office. Proceed to Park Avenue, Carhartt Avenue, and return to West Irvine School with continuous shuttles every 30 minutes.
- The Mountain Mushroom Festival funds will pay the bus driver's hourly rate as set by the school board and cost of fuel.
- An invoice will be prepared by the school board and presented to Irvine City Hall, Mountain Mushroom Festival, 101 Chestnut Street, Irvine, KY 40336 for the bus drivers' payment and fuel cost after the festival.
