How are Preschool Students Funded?

• The revised Kentucky Statute (KRS 157.3175), determines district preschool program funding based on the average number of preschool children served on December 1 and March 1 of the prior academic year.

• The sum of the December 1 and March 1 average is multiplied by per-child rates. The per-child rates are approved by the Kentucky Board of Education.

• The funding enrollment numbers are pulled from the Infinite Campus report Preschool Enrollment Count.

• Therefore, it is essential that districts make sure that all eligible preschool children are accurately on or before each of the determining dates.

- 8. Early Kindergarten and Preschool registration will be held on April 3rd, starting at 5:30pm. We have 15 Preschool students who will be moving on to Kindergarten next year.
