**Student Achievement:** CHHS Wrestling Team, that includes several of our students, placed 1st at the Boyle Country tournament over the weekend. Students have started IReady testing and approximately 180 students have already completed math. We have already seen a 6% reduction in students one grade level below and an 11% increase in students performing on grade level.

**Previous/Ongoing Business:** We are still taking nominations for a SBDM minority parent. Christin Swords shared the 22-23 KSA testing data, specifically focusing on gaps/trends noticed between sub populations of students. The needs assessment was reviewed in relation to CSIP goals. An update was provided on our progress toward our 3 year goals.

**New Business:** We reviewed the CSIP goals, objectives, strategies, progress monitoring and more. Some minor revisions were suggested and they have been made. We also reviewed CSIP Phases I-II. Candace Perry motioned to approve the CSIP, and Amelia Tarrence seconded it.
