


# Meet the PUBLIC RELATIONS Co-Op Team

positions this school year.




### **PR CO-OP STUDENTS**



### **Facebook Follwers**


GCS Facebook now has 5.8K followers, gaining 456 this school year, a 25.5% increase from last year.





### **Facebook Profile Visits**


GCS Facebook Page had 80,473 visits since August, a 10.5% increase from the previous year.





#### Facebook Reach


GCS Facebook reached 177.0K accounts since August, up by 5% from the previous year.


### **Instagram Followers**
