HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Northern Kentucky Institute for Arts Education in conjunction with the Northern Kentucky Cooperative for Educational Services (NKCES) is providing resources to schools, art experiences and opportunities for students, and professional learning for teachers by providing the amount of \$31,985.00 for one year to each school awarded the AIM grant. Fort Wright Elementary, Piner Elementary, and Turkey Foot Middle School have all participated in prior years. Schools are only able to receive the grant for two years. For the 2024-2025 school year, Ryland Elementary and Scott High School have applied and been accepted to be recipients of the Arts in Mind (AIM) program grant. This grant will allow for each school to receive training, stipends for professional learning, art materials, and art experiences for students.

- Purchase materials totaling at least \$16,700.00 for each participating school as identified on the school's *Comprehensive Arts Plan* and as approved by NKCES. Materials include instructional materials, digital resources, instruments, supplies, and tools, including adaptive tools, that support all learners, including disadvantaged students and students with disabilities, in the visual and performing arts (art, dance, music, and theatre).
- Provide receipts or other documentation of materials purchased.

- By March 22, 2024, submit a completed *Needs Assessment* and *Comprehensive Arts Plan* for each participating school, following templates, guidelines, and timelines provided by NKCES.
- Pay expenses totaling at least \$8,500 for arts experiences at each participating school as identified on the school's *Comprehensive Arts Plan* and as approved by NKCES. Experiences include teaching artists' visits, arts assemblies, and arts field trips supporting instruction in the visual and performing arts (art, dance, music, and theatre). Funds may be used to pay teaching artists or organizations, admission for students and relevant adults, transportation, and other allowable costs directly related to each arts experience.
- Provide receipts or other documentation of allowable expenses.
