Consider/Approve A revision to the high quality comprehensive instructional resource five-year plan.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

01.1 Legal Status of the Board

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

In March 2023, the board received and approved a five- year plan for high quality comprehensive instructional resources. Through collaboration with building principals to include most recently during our February District Leadership meeting, the recommendation is to remove the rotation of the Science/Social Studies/Electives. In the current plan, the district allocated each school approximately \$39 per student to apply towards these areas beginning in the 25-26 school year and again in the 27-28 school year if the school had a need in the area of Science/Social Studies/Electives. Many of our schools are either already functioning with a resource in these areas or have a need outside of this timeline. A list of high-quality comprehensive resources in the area of Science and Social Studies has been vetted by the district office to support schools in the selection of a resource if needed.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

This revision would deduct approximately \$1,000,000 from this five-year plan.
