Attendance at Lincoln –

The percentage of our students attending school regularly has drastically improved this school year. This is due to our intentional work of putting specific systems and steps into place. We have set up a tiered system of supports similar to academic and behavior interventions to assist students and their families with attendance needs. These interventions have proven to make an important impact for our students. This work is intense and so very important.

The Science of Reading – Our literacy work with *The Reading League* continues with our current work including:

- **TEACHER COACHING** - Continued coaching by our coaches, Rachel and Stefany. Our coaches meet with teachers individually and virtually every 2-3 weeks.
- **PROFESSIONAL LEARNING** – LES staff participated in recent TRL virtual trainings on early-release dates in Jan/Feb:
 - *Explicit Instructional Routines*
 - *PreK Literacy Universal Screening Tool*
- **ON-GOING LEARNING** – The dates for our 24-25 Science of Reading trainings have been set for our teachers and staff. It is critical that our learning in this area is on-going and that we stay committed to growing our knowledge.

Benchmark Assessments – Our students completed their Winter STAR and Winter AIMSweb Benchmark testing prior to winter break. Our students are currently taking their *Winter MAP* benchmark assessments. We are VERY pleased with the students' growth progress on EACH of these assessments and will use this important winter data to enhance and make needed changes to our new WIN ("What I Need") groups. These groups are created to meet students' academic needs. Each grade level's WIN groups consist of groups for Gifted and Talented, on grade level, and also intervention groupings.

Camp Joy – We are currently in the middle of another Camp Joy campaign to fully fund our overnight 5th grade trip for EVERY student. Our goal is to raise enough money to send every fifth grader to Camp Joy free of charge. So far we are at 83% of reaching our goal!

Making Lincoln Special -

- Fine Arts – Every student at Lincoln is exposed to the arts through in-school or out-of-school opportunities that are focused in the four types of art forms – dance, visual art, music or dance.
- Field Trips -- Our students are all continuing to get opportunities to learn outside of the classroom by participating in: intentionally planned grade level field trips; club field trips and Arts enriched field trips; gifted and talented field trips; etc.
- Clubs – All of our afterschool clubs continue at Lincoln with 2-4 clubs happening every day after school. We are excited that *Girls on the Run* is back at Lincoln and has just begin! Our school play, *The Wizard of Oz* is scheduled for April.
- 21st Century – Our 21st Century program continues to serve close to 90 students daily after school Monday – Thursday!
- PTC Events – School Dances – Country Western themed dances 2/23 and 3/08
- Devil Store – Our students continue to work to follow our *Greendevil Promise* by earning marks on their Devil cards which allows them to shop weekly at our Devil Store. This store is funded through donations.
- Incentives – Our students continue to be rewarded for their efforts! We have monthly attendance incentives, academic incentives and monthly assemblies. During each of these events, we are recognizing individuals and/or classrooms for their great efforts.
