The After-School Instructor for High School Students is responsible for providing guidance, support, and mentorship to high school students participating in the after-school program. This role involves building positive relationships with students, assisting with academic and personal development, and serving as a role model and advocate for their success.

- 1. Build trusting and supportive relationships with high school students, serving as a positive role model and mentor.
- 2. Provide guidance and encouragement to students in setting and achieving academic, personal, and career goals.
- 3. Listen actively to students' concerns, offering empathy, understanding, and constructive feedback.
- 4. Provide academic tutoring and support in specific subject areas as needed.
- 5. Help students develop effective time management and organizational skills to improve academic performance.
- 6. Promote positive peer relationships and foster a supportive and inclusive after-school community.
- 7. Facilitate engagement activities to support a positive learning experiences within the school and with peers.
