This Participating Addendum Commonwealth Master Agreement ("PA" or "Participating Addendum") is made this 1 day of March, 2021 (the "PA Effective Date"), between the Commonwealth of Kentucky ("Participating Entity" or "Commonwealth") and AT&T Corp. ("Contractor").

Section 1. Recitals.

- 1.1 AT&T Corp. ("Contractor") and the State of Utah, acting through its Department of Administration, Purchasing Division, and the participating members of the NASPO ValuePoint, a division of the National Association of State Procurement Officials ("NASPO"), are parties to that certain wireless communication services and equipment contract #MA149, dated, December 6, 2019, as amended (the "Contract" or "NASPO Master Agreement").
- 1.2 Participating Entity wants to participate in the NASPO Master Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions of this PA for awarded Categories one (1), two (2), and three (3).
- Category 1: Cellular Wireless Services
 - Category 2: Equipment and Accessories
 - (EXCLUDES tablets and video cameras)
 - Category 3: Turnkey Wireless and IoT Solutions
 - Offered as a Product to include NetMotion, Fleet Manager, Rave, and SmartPrepare.
 - The Commonwealth reserves the right to add other products in the future.

Section 2. Agreement.

In consideration of the recitals set forth in §1 above, which are hereby re-stated and agreed to by the Parties, and for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Parties, Participating Entity and Contractor hereby agree to the terms and conditions of this PA (the NASPO Master Agreement and this PA, together with all valid Purchase Orders submitted to Contractor by Participating Entity, collectively, the "Agreement"). Unless otherwise defined, capitalized terms in this PA have the meanings ascribed to them in the NASPO Master Agreement

Section 3. Authorized Purchasing Entities.

The Commonwealth hereby designates **all government entities** within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including all State agencies to include all branches of government and political subdivisions to include public safety institutions, public schools and institutions of higher education as authorized Purchasing Entities under this Agreement.

Section 4. Purchase Orders.

Except as set forth herein, all Purchase Orders must reference both the NASPO Master Agreement #MA149-1 and this Participating Addendum Commonwealth Master Agreement, MA 758 2100000435, to be valid. Upon acceptance of any such valid Purchase Order, the corresponding Purchasing Entity will be bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement including, without limitation, the obligation to pay Contractor for Service, Equipment, and related Products provided. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any Purchase Order submitted that does not properly reference the NASPO Master Agreement number and/or this PA may be accepted, at Contractor's sole discretion, if Contractor can reasonably ascertain that such Purchase Order was properly authorized and intended for use with this PA. In such instances, the corresponding Purchase Order will be similarly valid and binding. Terms and conditions inserted into a Purchase Order by a Purchasing Entity that are inconsistent with, contrary to, or in addition to the terms and conditions of this Agreement will not be added to or incorporated into this Agreement. Any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected and such inconsistent, contrary, and/or additional terms are void.

Section 6. Authority.

By signing below, the corresponding Party's representative represents that he or she is duly authorized by Contractor or Participating Entity, as applicable, to execute this PA on behalf of the respective Party, and that the Contractor and Participating Entity agree to be bound by the provisions hereof. In addition, Participating Entity represents that it has received the requisite approvals from the applicable Chief Procurement Official and NASPO to participate in the NASPO Master Agreement.

Section 7. Miscellaneous.

7.1 Employee Benefit Program. The Contractor shall provide a state employee benefit program. The Contractor shall provide employees of the Purchasing Entity a fifteen percent (15%) employee discount on eligible personal wireless services, available consumer promotional pricing for devices, and waived Start of Service and Upgrade fees.

7.2 Upgrades. The Contractor shall allow for an upgrade every eighteen (18) months.

7.3 Activation/Suspension Fees. The Commonwealth shall not be charged an activation fee or suspension fee for government liable lines.

7.4 New Technology. Any new equipment that is commercially available and approved for use on the AT&T Wireless network shall be available for the Commonwealth to procure immediately.

7.5 Equipment. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth in NASPO MA 149, Attachment AA, the Contractor shall have available device(s) for \$0.99 for new activations or upgrades.

Section 8. Notice of Administrative Fees.

All Participating Entities are hereby on notice of the following charges being paid by Contractor under the Contract.

- Contract Fees Under the NASPO Master Agreement. Contractor is being charged an Administrative Fee of: (i) 0.25% of all CRUs' Total Wireless Spend; and (ii) 0.10% of all IRUs' Total Wireless Spend of the Total Wireless Spend, pursuant to the schedule of payments set forth in the Contract.

Section 9. Order of Precedence.

Notwithstanding the Order of Precedence set forth in this Agreement, the Parties Acknowledge and agree that in the event of a conflict between the terms contained in the various documents comprising this Agreement, the following order of precedence will control: (a) this PA; (b) the NASPO Master Agreement; and (c) any valid Purchase Order issued in connection therewith/.

Section 10. Governing Law.

This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of The Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Section 11. Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans – Agency Paid.

Provided Participating Entity remains in full compliance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and subject to all corresponding conditions set forth in this §11 (including all sub-sections and Tables), AT&T will provide Participating Entity and its eligible CRUs the custom FirstNet Mobile Plans described in §11 (the “Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans”). The Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans are available for the term of this Agreement. The corresponding CRU must be eligible to activate Service on the underlying, non-customized version of the corresponding FirstNet Mobile Plan. The Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans are not available to IRUs or to individuals eligible to purchase the subscriber paid versions of FirstNet Mobile Plans. In accordance with this Agreement, the Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans are subject to the applicable, standard FirstNet Mobile-Pooled and Mobile-Unlimited Plans’ corresponding Sales Information, which are incorporated herein by reference. To the extent of any material conflict between the terms and conditions of this §11. and the applicable Sales Information, this §11. will control. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans will be provided only if Participating Entity’s account is active and in good standing with respect to the applicable CRU. The Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans are NOT eligible for the Service Discount, any other discount provided under this Agreement, nor any other discounts or promotions otherwise available to AT&T’s customers. For all Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans, the corresponding Plan’s Monthly Service Charge will appear on the invoice at the standard price set forth in the Sales Information, but the customized net monthly price set forth in the corresponding table will be achieved via application of a modifier also reflected on the invoice. The term “MSC” in the tables below means “Monthly Service Charge.”

Section 12. Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans – Subscriber Paid.

In addition to FirstNet Mobile Plans available to Participating Entity and its CRUs, AT&T offers a subscriber paid version of such plans to eligible individuals associated with a Primary User Public Safety Entity. Participating Entity hereby authorizes AT&T to provide such individuals with the discounts set forth in §12 (the “Custom FirstNet Mobile Subscriber Paid Plans”). Participating Entity must remain eligible for the Custom FirstNet Mobile Plans described in §11 for the Custom FirstNet Mobile Subscriber Paid Plans to apply. The corresponding subscriber must be eligible to activate Service on the underlying, non-customized version of the corresponding FirstNet Mobile Subscriber Paid Plan. The Custom FirstNet Mobile Subscriber Paid Plans are not available to Participating Entity, its CRUs, or its IRUs. For all Custom FirstNet Mobile Subscriber Paid Plans, the corresponding Plan’s Monthly Service Charge will appear on the invoice at the standard price set forth in the Sales Information, but the customized net monthly price set forth in the corresponding table will be achieved via application of a modifier also reflected on the invoice.

Section 13. Custom Offers.

Provided Participating Entity remains in full compliance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and subject to all corresponding restrictions and conditions set forth in this §13 (including all sub-sections and Tables), Contractor will provide Participating Entity and its eligible CRUs the following custom offers: (a) the custom AT&T Business National Flat Rate Plan described in §13.1 herein (the “Custom Business National Flat Rate Plan”); (b) the custom AT&T Pooled Data Connect 5G Plan described in §13.2 herein (the “Custom Pooled Data Connect Plan”); (c) the custom pooled voice only plans described in §13.3 herein (the “Custom Pooled Voice Only Plans”); (d) the custom pooled plans with unlimited data described in §13.4 herein (the “Custom Pooled Plans with Unlimited Data”); (e) the custom integrated tethering plans described in §13.5 herein (the “Custom Integrated Tethering Plans”; and (f) the custom AT&T Fleet Manager for Government pricing described in §13.6 herein (the “Custom Fleet Manager Plans”) (the, Custom Business National Flat Rate Plan, the Custom Pooled Data Connect Plan, the Recurring Credits, the Custom Pooled Voice Only Plan the Custom Pooled Plans with Unlimited Data, the Custom Integrated Tethering Plans, and the Custom Fleet Manager Plans are, at times, referred to together herein as the “Custom Offers”). **The Custom Offers are expressly conditioned upon the terms and conditions of §14 herein.** The Custom Offers are available for the term of this Agreement. The Custom Offers are NOT eligible for the Service Discount, any other discount provided under the Agreement, nor any other discounts or promotions otherwise available to AT&T’s customers. For all Custom Offers, the corresponding CRU must be eligible to activate Service on the underlying, non-customized version of the Plan or offer. The Custom Offers are not available to IRUs. In accordance with the Agreement, each of the Custom Offers is subject to its underlying offer’s corresponding Sales Information, which is incorporated herein by reference. To the extent of any material conflict between the terms and

conditions of this §13 and the applicable Sales Information, this §13 will control. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Custom Offers will only be provided if Participating Entity's account is active and in good standing with respect to the applicable CRU.

13.1 Custom Business National Flat Rate Plan.

In order to be eligible for the Custom Business National Flat Rate Plan, Participating Entities must maintain a monthly average of one hundred (100) billable minutes of use per CRU measured across all its CRUs activated on the Custom Business National Flat Rate Plan. The Custom Business National Flat Rate Plan is NOT eligible for the Service Discount.

Section 14. Exclusivity.

Participating Entity acknowledges and agrees that (a) Contractor will be Participant's exclusive provider of wireless service for the Commonwealth of Kentucky Executive Branch agencies. and (b) all the Custom Offers are expressly contingent on §14(a). Subject to the terms and conditions of this §14, in the event Contractor is not Participant's exclusive provider of wireless service, Contractor may, at its sole discretion (i) terminate all Custom Offers; and/or (ii) terminate this PA. In the event Contractor adds to or enhances Service coverage in the applicable geographic regions, then Contractor will be Participant's exclusive provider for wireless Service in those regions as soon as reasonably practical. Contractor will meet with Participant quarterly to review any changes to Contractor's Service coverage. If Participant notifies Contractor about lack of Service coverage in a specific location, and Contractor concurs that it cannot provide a Service solution there, then Participant may choose another wireless service provider for that specific need.

Section 15. Split Discount. Participant hereby exercises its right to retain a portion of the IRU Service Discount. IRUs will receive the first fifteen percent (15%) of the IRU Service Discount, and Participant will receive the remaining two percent (2%). Contractor will calculate Participant's portion of the IRU Service Discount each calendar quarter, and will pay it to Participant within a commercially reasonable time after the end of the corresponding calendar quarter.

Section 16. Reporting and Administrative Fees.

Contractor shall remit to Participating Entity an administrative fee in the amount of two percent (2%) of all CRU's Total Wireless Spend. CRU's Total Wireless Spend means, with respect to the administrative fee, the total amount of the charges set forth on the invoices sent by Contractor to Participating Entities under the Participating Addendum, less taxes, fees and surcharges. Regulatory Fees and Surcharges include, but are not limited to, the FUSF/UCC (Federal Universal Service Fee / Universal Connectivity Charge), the AEF (Administrative Expense Fee), the FRF (Federal Regulatory Fee), the PTA (Property Tax Allotment), the FARF (Federal Access Recovery Fee), the CLC (Carrier Line Charge), and the SLC/EUCL (Subscriber Line Charge / End User Carrier Line charge). Unit prices are inclusive of the administrative fee and Contractor is not to charge the fee directly in the form of a separate line item.

Quarterly Reporting and Fee Remittance:

Contractor shall submit to Participating Entity a Sales Report documenting all CRU's Total Wireless Spend, made during the applicable reporting period and such submission, including any supplemental information submitted, is deemed a public record.

Quarterly Sales Reports shall be emailed to Jim Barnhart, Deputy CIO, at jim.barnhart@ky.gov and Holly McDonald, Commonwealth Buyer, at holly.mcdonald@ky.gov. The Sales Report shall be submitted no later than forty-five (45) days after the end of each calendar quarter, and the related administrative fee shall be remitted no later than sixty (60) calendar days after the end of each calendar quarter. The calendar quarters will end March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31. The Sales Report will contain the following information:

- Complete and accurate details of all sales, credits, and the like for the reporting quarter;
- Purchasing Entity Foundation Account Name;
- Total of convenience fee amount due; and
