This grant application is completed through KDE with grant funding opportunities through the KY Governor's Office of Early Childhood. The incentive grant program represents an opportunity for school districts and childcare providers to improve the quality of services in their communities. The grant funding is over an 18 month period with all funds required to be encumbered by December 2025.
