<u>Consent Agenda Item (Action Item)</u>: Consider/Approve contract between the Floyd County Board of Education and Cintas for AED lease program. Due to the number of extracurricular activities taking place simultaneously at several schools it is now necessary that we add 6 additional outside AED's to our lease agreement with Cintas. The additional outside units will be added to SFES, PHS, BLHS, AMS, FC and DACE,

#### **Applicable State or Regulations:**

- KRS 311.665
- KRS 311.667
- HB 331 sets requirements that must be met by the 2025-2026 school year that school administrators must maintain a portable AED in a public, readily accessible, well-marked location of every middle and high school building at every school.
- Board Policy 1.11 Powers and duties of the local board.

#### **Budget/Financial Issues:**

General Fund Expense. Each AED Unit is priced at \$140.00 (lease) which includes: medical prescription for each unit, online management program for all units, AED cabinet and soft carry bag, prep and response kits, back-up AED pads for each unit, AED signs for each unit, Free pads/battery replacement, free software upgrades, free on-site monthly status checks by trained Cintas technician and free replacement of unit if software issues occur. Hard shell water proof cases will be included with the additional 6 units without charge as a courtesy.

### **Background and Rationale:**

As the school year has progressed and kids have settled in with their classmates and extracurricular teammates. This is an ideal time for parents, educators, and administrators to understand the importance of life saving devices called Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) and the precautions that FCS has in place for the safety of students and staff, After calling 911, an AED would be used if the individual suffers cardiac arrest. The AED unit walks users through the process step by step. Most people would not survive a cardiac event because

people around them are either untrained or hesitant to step in. All of our schools currently have AED's in the buildings and strategically placed units are available at the on-site athletic fields. Due to response time and the location of athletic fields AED's must be available for quick access by trained individuals. It has now become necessary to add 6 additional units to our agreement. To insure the safety of students during activities. The present agreement includes maintenance by Cintas for 32 units and with the added six units that number will increase to 39 units. To insure access to AED's in emergency situations that may occur during outside athletic events it is vital that we add 6 additional units to our current lease. The outside units will be placed in hard cases and remain with the head coach during activities. Each coach will return the units to school administrator or health office after the activity to be checked out by the next activity coach. The AED's housed inside the buildings are stored in soft cases in cabinets that are not water proof. These should not be taken outside of the school to ensure that the AED's are available in the buildings at all times.

The current lease with Cintas has provided us with the updated version of the ZOLL AED's. Our ZOLL Plus AED/Cintas lease provides us with monthly checks, pad replacement, unit replacement and medical oversight by a physician. The ZOLL AED 3 has provided our district with the most updated technology as well as eliminated the expense of buying both adult and pediatric pads as the unit comes with one pad that can be adapted to adult and pediatric use with an adjustment. Floyd County Schools Extracurricular Coaches, Bus Drivers, Monitors, Paraprofessionals and all Health Staff are CPR, AED and First Aide Certified.






