## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- The fourth PD day was Friday, March 17. There were a few teachers that were in district completing their last six hour of professional learning.
- Both schools will be completing a Professional Learning Needs Assessment.
- Summer Professional Learning will take place again this summer. The focus will be curriculum alignment, assessment development, and Tier II vocabulary.

## **ASSESSMENT**

- The state administration of the All juniors took the ACT on Tuesday, March 12.
- ACT District Testing took place on Tuesday, March 12. We had close 40 freshmen and sophomores take the District ACT.
- The final round of STAR testing will occur in April.
- KSA is scheduled for the last 14 days of school. There is no more five day window that KSA has to be administered. Our first day of KSA is Friday, May 3.

## **CURRICULUM/INSTRUCTION**

- The Dayton Schools Arts Plan is attached to my report.
- We recently completed GROW Meetings with teachers in grades K 6. We reviewed district wide STAR data as well curriculum documents with all teachers. We also shared the KSA testing released items and TestNav Tutorial.
- The six step lesson plan is up and running at DHS. Close to 50 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are working with 7 teachers at DHS. Groups will be changing after spring break to reflect skill deficiencies that students have displayed on the QPS assessment.
