

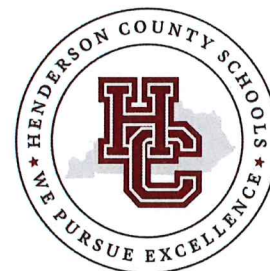

Re: HPD Police Camp 2024

Dear Mr. Alexander:

The City of Henderson Police Department (HPD) is partnering with the Brain Injury Adventure Camp (BIAC) to host a youth police camp. The participants will be graduating 5th graders who will be nominated by local elementary schools. There will be no cost for the camp. The dates for the camp are June 10th through June 13th.

We are requesting bus transportation for the students and a couple of police department chaperones from the police department to BIAC, then back to the police department at the end of the day for the duration of the camp. Students will meet at the police department located at 1990 Barret Court by 7:30 a.m. each morning and be transported to BIAC. The camp will conclude at 5:00 p.m. on Monday through Wednesday and students will be transported back to HPD. The camp will conclude at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday and students will be transported back to HPD. The address for BIAC is 2001 Northern Star Way, Robards, KY. The mileage is 33 miles, and it is expected to take approximately one (1) hour round trip per day to commute.
