Student of the Month academic theme this month is Reading.

- Read to Succeed Act
 - Teachers are currently researching and looking through samples of literary resources to choose an
 alternative to Scholastic Literacy. Due to changes from Senate Bill 9, Scholastic isn't approved by
 EdReports for early literacy and therefore isn't considered a High-Quality Instructional Resource
 (HQIR).

 - Or. Mandy Barrett from Solution Tree has visited us twice to assist with the process of identifying our Essential Standards and deconstructing those standards into learning targets. We'll continue to work on these this school year and into the summer. Dr. Barrett will be visiting again April 24^{th} and May 2^{nd} .

 - All classroom teachers were invited to attend one of the four internal labs where they attended a pre-brief before school to gather information from the host about the lesson being observed, an observation of an entire class period, and then a debrief after school to synthesize their own learning and offer constructive feedback to the lab host.

- 3rd Grade CoGAT Testing was completed March 25th-29th. We look forward to seeing that data and determining students that qualify for Gifted and Talented services for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Spring MAP testing was April 1st-5th. Teachers assisted students in setting individual MAP goals for both reading and math. Preliminary data show significant growth from Winter to Spring MAP.
- We are currently planning professional development for 2024-2025 school year. Teachers filled out a PD survey to help determine school-wide priorities and needs. We will utilize this feedback to assist in planning.
- We have planned Grandview summer learning and sent out registration forms to families. Summer learning will be June 3rd, 28th.
