Legislative Process

- HB114 (Governor's Recommendation) introduced January 16, 2024
- HB6 (with House Committee Substitute) sent to Senate February 2, 2024
- HB6 (with Senate Committee Substitute) passed March 13, 2024
- HB6 (Free Conference Committee) delivered to Governor March 28, 2024
- Legislature has sixty working days with the last day being April 15, 2024
- Governor has ten days to sign, line-item veto or veto in entirety



SEEK - HB6 FCCR

- Per Pupil \$4326 in FY25, \$4586 in FY26
- SEEK lapse to Budget Reserve Trust Fund in both fiscal years
- Tier I district may levy an equivalent tax rate which will produce up to 17.5 percent of those revenues guaranteed by the SEEK Program
- Property Assessment Growth Relief
- Includes additional funding for pupil transportation

SEEK - HB6 FCCR

- Full-day kindergarten included
- Star Academy \$5M in FY26 to support a three-year pilot program of five Star Academy charter schools within existing public schools
- Legislative Policy Requirement language
 - requires districts to prominently display on the local board of education's website, proficient and distinguished percentages in reading and math; KDE shall post a rank order by overall performance of all schools on KDE's website.
 - 2024 General Assembly encourages local school districts to provide certified and classified staff a salary or compensation increase.

District Salary Compensation

 Certified and Classified Staff - Additional funds have been made available to local school districts through increases in SEEK resources. The 2024 General Assembly encourages local school districts to provide certified and classified staff a salary or compensation increase.

State Employee Salary Compensation

- HB6 FCCR
 - Salary Increment 3% increment effective July 1, 2024, 3% increment effective July 1, 2025.

Other Education Funding

- School Facilities Construction Commission
 - Additional Offers of Assistance: Notwithstanding KRS 157.611 to 157.665, the School Facilities Construction Commission is authorized to make an additional \$40,000,000 in offers of assistance during the 2024-2026 fiscal biennium in anticipation of debt service availability during the 2026-2028 fiscal biennium. No bonded indebtedness based on the above amount is to be incurred during the 2024-2026 fiscal biennium.
 - School Facility Assistance Fund awards to districts that are A1 or A2 schools and ranked priority 1 or 2 on the district's facility plan. FY26 only.

- No local school districts receiving offers of assistance under this Act shall be eligible to receive additional offers of assistance until the 2028-2030 fiscal biennium.



Other Education Funding

- Health and Family Svcs Cabinet Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC) - \$3.95M for additional centers that currently serve more than one school
- Auditor of Public Accounts Jefferson County Public Schools Audit \$750K
- KHEAA Teacher Scholarship Program \$2M each fiscal year
- KHEAA Student Teacher Stipend Program \$7.3M each fiscal year to provide a \$5000 stipend for each student completing this certification requirement
- HB1 FCCR \$2.5M for the purchase of automated external defibrillators for public schools
