Sports Information:

The boys basketball team finished the season with a record of 26-7. They won the 6<sup>th</sup> District Tournament and lost in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Finals to the eventual state champion, Lyon County.

The girls basketball team finished the season 26-8. They won the 6<sup>th</sup> District Tournament, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Tournament and their first game at the KHSAA Girls Sweet 16 State Tournament. This is the 6<sup>th</sup> year in a row that we have advanced to the state tournament.

The girls archery team won the 1<sup>st</sup> Region Team title. They will participate at the KHSAA State Archery Tournament on Tuesday, April 16.

The baseball team is currently 6-9. Many of the players have moved up from JV last year and are adjusting to the varsity level.

The softball team is currently 14-1 and currently ranked #3 in the state RPI rankings.

The girls tennis team is 3-1 and the boys are 4-0. Several matches have been canceled or rescheduled due to inclement weather.

The track team has increased the number of participants significantly. There are over 50 boys and 40 girls on the roster. Nine athletes qualified for the indoor state meet. Andrew O'Nan finished 6<sup>th</sup> in the state in the shot put. At the Spring Relays in Owensboro, the boys finished 2<sup>nd</sup> and the girls finished 3<sup>rd</sup>. Both teams finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the Daviess County Invitational. At the Colonel Classic, our boys were 2<sup>nd</sup> and the girls were 3<sup>rd</sup>.
