The MCPS Student Ambassadors hosted the annual Young Leaders Conference on Saturday, March 16 at Marion County High School.








The EL and Migrant Education Program hosted a Multicultural Night recently at Marion County Knight Academy. The event highlighted the different cultures throughout the community.
