**Recommendation/Motion:** A motion is in order to use Capital Outlay Funds for a hand washing station in the Henry Clay Field House (\$11,785) and for an ADA access lift at Northern Elementary (\$13,309).

**Background/Rationale:** The girls handing washing station at Henry Clay High School is inoperable and a lift is needed at Northern Elementary to grant access to students with mobility issues. In April 2022, The Board of Education adopted a resolution pertaining to HB 678 that provides greater flexibility to local boards of education related to the funding, financing, design, construction, renovation, or modification of facilities. To save general funds dollars for instructional purposes, restricted capital funds can be applied to facility needs. To utilize the remaining restricted fund sources for 2023-2024, the Board of Education must approve Capital Funds Request for the recommended repairs at Henry Clay and Northern.
